In economics, stagflation, a portmanteau of stagnation and inflation, is a situation in which the inflation rate is high, the economic growth rate slows, and unemployment remains steadily high. It raises a dilemma for economic policy, since actions designed to lower inflation may have the unintended consequence of increasing unemployment. The term "stagflation" was first coined during a period of inflation and high unemployment in the early 1970s. Because of these views, both monetary and fiscal policy were carefully managed for over 15 years in the face of the obvious continued rise in inflation. This was a flawed view in the early and late 1970s despite rapidly rising inflation.
